The partnership is designed to address critical gaps in healthcare access by combining FICF's expertise in healthcare space and its support to Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme with CSB Bank's strong community presence. Together, we are working to provide life-saving treatment to those who need it most, making a tangible impact on the lives of patients and their families. Project 'Green Spot' – Indore Municipal Corporation

Bank extended support to Indore Municipal Corporation towards the “Green Spot Project”, a tree plantation campaign aimed at increasing the green cover and improving air quality of the city. The total project cost was approximately ₹ 30 lakhs. The project envisages the plantation of saplings on both sides and on the



middle strip of the road stretch from Gopur Chauraha to Phuti Kothi Chauraha. This initiative helps to improve ecological balance, promote environmental sustainability and enhance urban green infrastructure.

Project 'Clean City' - Thrissur Corporation

Bank extended support to the Project "Clean City" an innovative plan of Thrissur Corporation aimed at strengthening household-level wet waste management within the Corporation limits. The project facilitates the installation of bio-compost bins in households, enabling residents to effectively manage organic waste generated at source. The initiative promotes cleaner surroundings, reduces waste burden on municipal systems, and contributes to environmental sustainability. The total project cost was ₹13.2 crore.

Women Empowerment Programme – Kadavallur Grama Panchayat

Upgradation of Research Centre and Computer Laboratories Sree Krishna College and Sree Krishna Higher Secondary School, Guruvayur

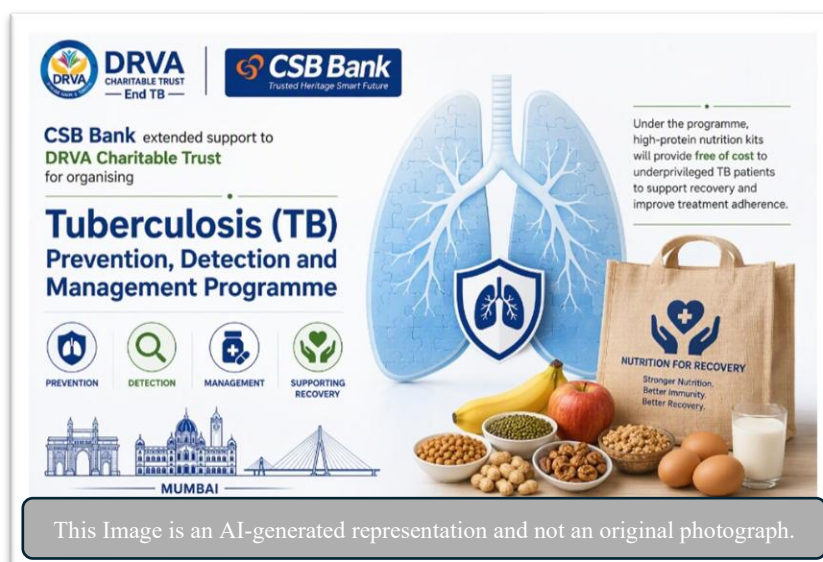
Bank extended support for the upgradation of Research Centre and computer laboratories at Sree Krishna College and Sree Krishna Higher Secondary School, Guruvayur, institutions owned and managed by Guruvayur Devaswom Board. Under the project, 30 computer systems were donated to the Computer Lab and Research Centre of Sree Krishna College and 22 computer systems to Sree Krishna Higher Secondary School. The initiative aims to strengthen the digital infrastructure of the institutions and enhance access to technology enabled learning for students, including those from economically weaker sections. The upgraded facilities are expected to support academic, research and skill development activities, improve digital literacy, and equip students with essential technological competencies required in a rapidly evolving digital environment.

Under the programme, high-protein nutrition kits will provide free of cost to underprivileged TB patients to support recovery and improve treatment adherence. The initiative aims to enhance the nutritional status and overall well-being of TB-affected individuals, thereby contributing to better treatment outcomes. Assistance for procurement of Advanced Cancer Diagnostic Equipment – Saveetha Institute of Medical & Technical Sciences

Bank extended partial financial assistance to Saveetha Institute of Medical and Technical Sciences towards the procurement of uMI 550 Digital PET/CT Scanner, an advanced medical imaging system that combines Positron Emission Tomography (PET) with an 80-slice Computed Tomography (CT) scanner. The total project cost was approximately ₹11 crore.

The scanner facilitates high-resolution whole-body imaging, enabling accurate diagnosis, staging and monitoring of cancer and other diseases. Equipped with advanced digital detector technology, it enhances diagnostic precision, supports faster clinical workflows and aids early detection and personalized treatment planning. The project is expected to strengthen the hospital's diagnostic capabilities and improve access to quality and affordable cancer diagnosis and follow-up treatment, particularly for economically disadvantaged sections of society.
